

Finding your way to the King Alfred Campus



Travelling by car, Park and Ride and on foot

If driving on the M3, come off at junction 11 and pass through Badger Farm Road turning right at the second roundabout to proceed along Romsey Road. After passing West Downs on your left and the Royal Hampshire County Hospital on your right, turn right into St James' Lane. After a sharp corner turn right into Sparkford Road. The King Alfred Campus is halfway down the hill on the right hand side. **Parking is freely available on campus from 4pm.**

The South Winchester Park and Ride is accessible from Junction 11 of the M3. Please see the map above for details.

By train

The King Alfred Campus is approximately 15 minutes walk from the railway station. Leave the station by the main exit and turn right into Station Road leading into Upper High Street. Turn right over the bridge and left into Clifton Terrace. Cross Romsey Road and walk along St James' Terrace. At the end of the terrace turn to your right and cross the road. Then follow the path through the middle of West Hill Cemetery (note: do not take the path to the left of the cemetery).
